- (1) A member entitled to attend, speak and vote at the GM is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend, speak and vote on his/her behalf. To appoint as proxy a person other than the Chairman of the meeting insert the full name in the space provided. A proxy need not be a member of the Company but must attend at the GM to represent you.
- (2) Forms of proxy, together with any power of attorney or other authority under which it is executed or a notarially certified copy thereof, must be completed and, to be valid, must reach the Company's Registrars at Share Registrars Limited, The Courtyard, 17 West Street, Farnham, Surrey GU9 7DR not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the meeting.
- (3) If the appointer is a corporation, the form of proxy must be under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised.
- (4) The appointment of a proxy does not preclude a member from attending and voting at the meeting in person should they so wish.
- (5) In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the vote of the other registered holder(s) and for this purpose seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members.
- (6) Pursuant to Regulation 41 of the Uncertificated Securities Regulations 2001 (SI 2001/3755) Reg. 41(1) and (2) and paragraph 18 (c) The Companies Act 2006 (Consequential Amendments) (Uncertificated Securities) Order 2009, only those shareholders on the Register of Members at 11.00 a.m. on 12 March 2018 shall be entitled to attend and vote at the meeting in respect of the number of shares registered in their names at that time. If the meeting is adjourned by more than 48 hours, then to be so entitled, a shareholder must be entered on the Company's Register of Members at the time which is 48 hours excluding non business days before the time appointed for holding the adjourned meeting or, if the Company gives notice of the adjourned meeting, at the time specified in that notice.
- (7) To appoint more than one proxy, you may photocopy the form of proxy. Please indicate the proxy holder's name and the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy (which in aggregate shall not exceed the number of shares held by you). Please also indicate if the proxy is part of a multiple set of instructions being given. All forms must be signed and should be returned together in the same envelope. A failure to specify the number of shares each proxy appointment relates to, or specifying a number in excess of those held by you, may result in the appointment being invalid. - (8) As at the close of business on 23 February 2018, the Company's issued share capital comprised 207,269,370 ordinary shares of 0.01p each. Each ordinary share carries the right to one vote at a general meeting of the Company, and therefore the total number of voting rights in the Company as at the time and date given above is 207,269,370.
